- <u>Copy of current health insurance card</u> If Applicable (We are in network with PHS/Coventry/MHNet & Blue Cross/Blue Shield. We will file for Out-Of-Network Benefits if we are not in network with your insurance company.)
- <u>Copy of Medicaid/KanCare Card</u> If Applicable (We are In-Network with all KanCare MCO's United Healthcare Community Plan/Optum, Sunflower State Healthplan/Cenpatico, Amerigoup.)
- <u>Verification of Kansas Residency</u> (For adolescents, this can be a photo ID or Driver's License with current address or a Kansas Medicaid/KanCare Card. If this is not available, we can use the parent/guardian's Driver's License/ID or a utility bill with parent/guardian's name and current address.)
- <u>Verification of US Residency</u> (This can be the adolescents Social Security Card, Birth Certificate, or Certificate of Naturalization.)
- <u>Verification of Income</u> (This can be the parent/guardian's last 3 pay stubs, tax return, or a letter from a current employer. If you are not employed you may bring a letter from the person that is providing housing for you, stating that you are unemployed and your living expenses have been provided for you. They will need to sign, date, and put their relationship to you at the bottom of the letter.)
